

WHAT IS ... TOWN

An urban area that has a name, defined boundaries, and local government, and that is generally larger than a village and smaller than a city.

WHAT IS ... TOWN PLANNING

The **process** of managing **land resources**. It involves the control of existing and new **developments**, as well as **strategy** preparation to ensure manage future requirements. It is a **dynamic process** that changes in response to policy, development proposals and local needs.



NATIONAL PLANNING


It identify country general policies and strategic vision in different sectors along certain period of time (5 or 10 years), it covers:

REGIONAL PLANNING

It deals with the efficient placement of land-use activities, infrastructure, and settlement growth across a larger area of land than an individual city or town.



CITY PLANNING

- Land use plan (standards ,rates, areas) of residential, open spaces ,industry, entertainment ..
- **Circulation plan** (roads hierarchy , design and types).
- Services (types, hierarchy).
- Future city expansion.
