

NAME	DYNASTY	YEARS
Archaic Period	1-2	3100-2700 B.C.
Old Kingdom	3-6	2700-2200 B.C.
Intermediate Period	7-10	2200-2050 B.C.
Middle Kingdom	11-12	2050-1800 B.C.
Intermediate Period	13-17	1800-1570 B.C.
New Kingdom	18-20	1570-1085 B.C.
Post-Empire	21-31	1085-332 B.C.

#### The Ptolemaic Period: Introduction

- The Ptolemaic Kingdom was a Hellenistic kingdom based in Egypt.
- It was ruled by the Ptolemaic dynasty which started with Ptolemy 1 accession after the death of Alexander the Great in 323 BC.
- The era of Ptolemaic reign in Egypt is one of the most well documented time periods of the Hellenistic Era; a wealth of papyri written in Greek and Egyptian of the time have been discovered in Egypt




#### The Ptolemaic Period: Characteristics

- The Ptolemaic civilization called the Hellenistic because it was a mix between the Egyptian and Greek civilizations.
- Architectural Character:
  - 1. Simplicity
  - 2. Monumentality
  - 3. Solidity and Massiveness









#### The Ptolemaic Period: Changes


- There are not Long approaches and Guardian sphinxes
- The temple building is made up of four walls enclosing a rectangular space called the naos or chapel.
- 3. There are a Screen Wall instead of the two Pylons.
- 4. Columns are huge.
- 5. Lighting system. (No clearstory windows)
- 6. Series of walls (Edfu Myth).






#### The Temple Of Horus At Edfu: Introduction

- Was built in the Ptolemaic period between
  237 and 57 BCE.
- Is located in Egypt on the west bank of the Nile River between Esna and Aswan.
- It is the second largest temple in Egypt after Karnak.
- The temple dedicated to the falcon god Horus.





#### The Temple Of Horus At Edfu: Introduction


- A massive structure.
- Heavy and large elements.
- Made of limestone and sandstone.
- Consist of: 2 Pylons, open court, hypostyle hall, offering hall, the sanctuary.

#### The Temple Of Sobek And Horus: Introduction

- Man with the head of a crocodile and a headdress of feathers and a sun disk
- Sobek was a Nile god.
- Was connected with the Nile and protected the king.
- Live crocodiles were kept in pools at temples built by honor Sobek




#### The Temple Of Sobek And Horus: Introduction

- The temple is about 30 miles north of Aswan and was built during the Ptolemaic period.
- Is dedicated to Horus and Sobek God.




#### The Temple Of Sobek And Horus: Parts

 Everything is duplicated along the main axis. There are two entrances, two courts, two hypostyle halls and two sanctuaries.














