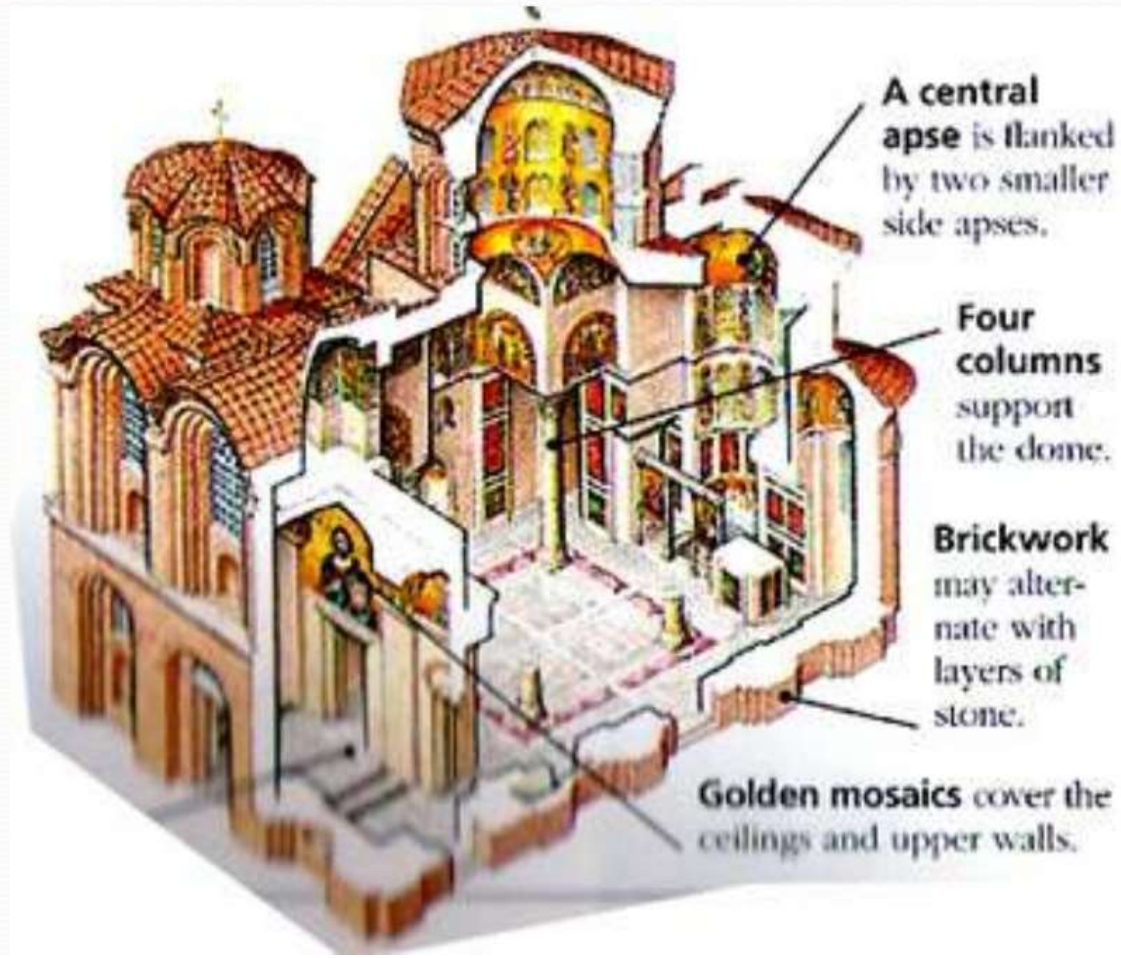

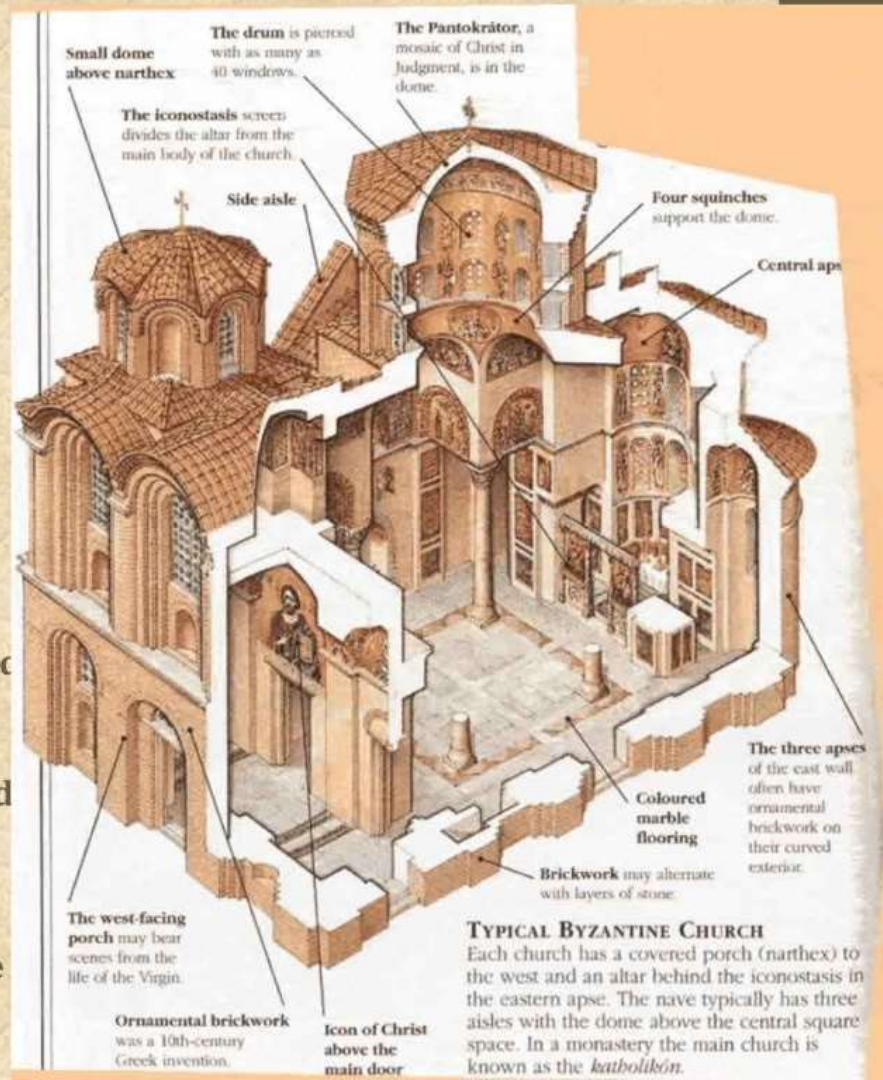
## Historical Background Location

- Early Christian architecture occurred in Rome and in areas around Rome

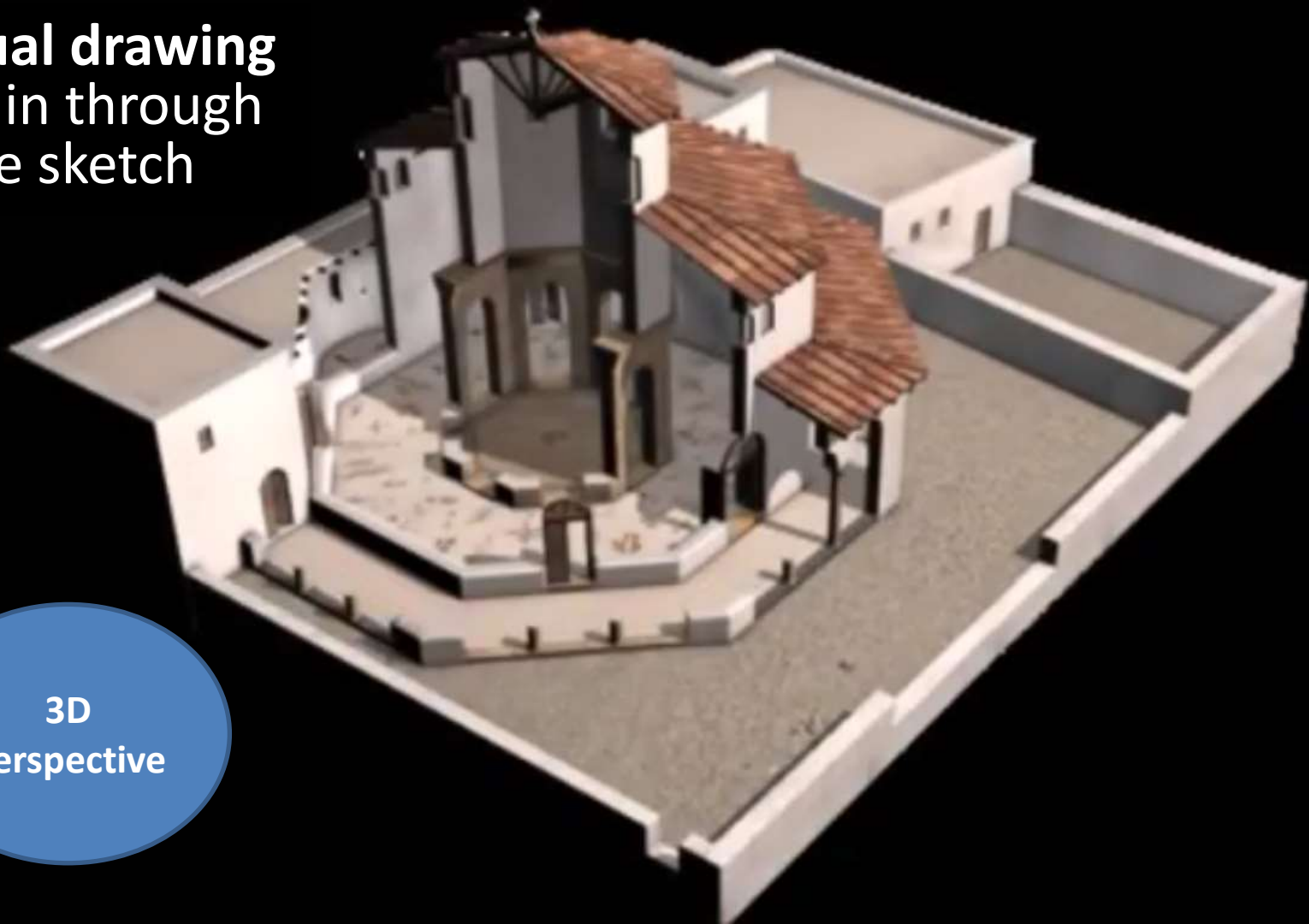
- Byzantine architecture was centered at Byzantium
