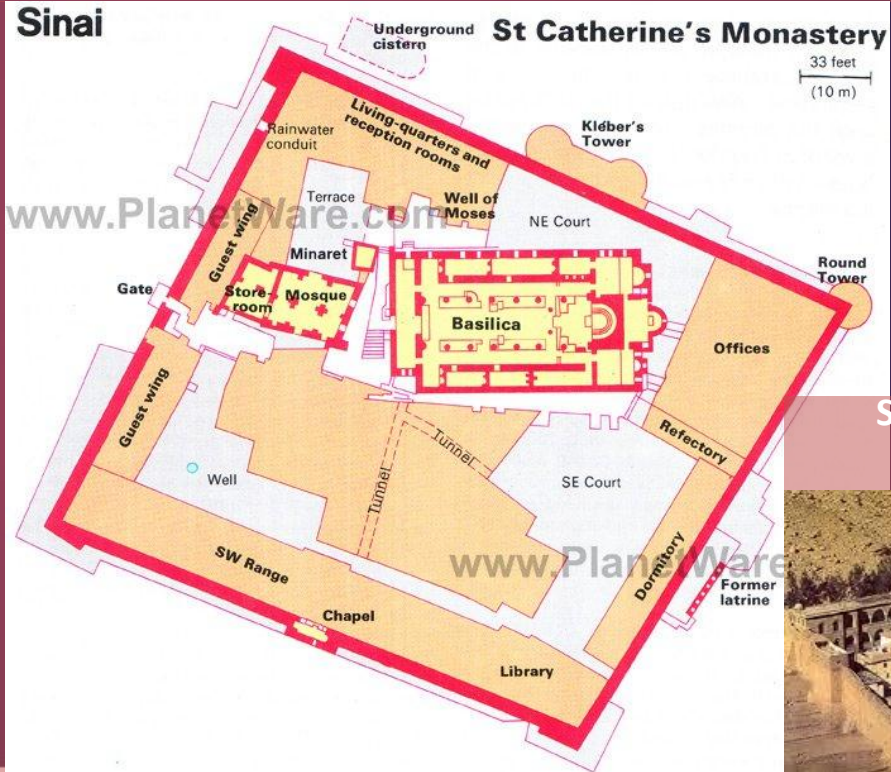

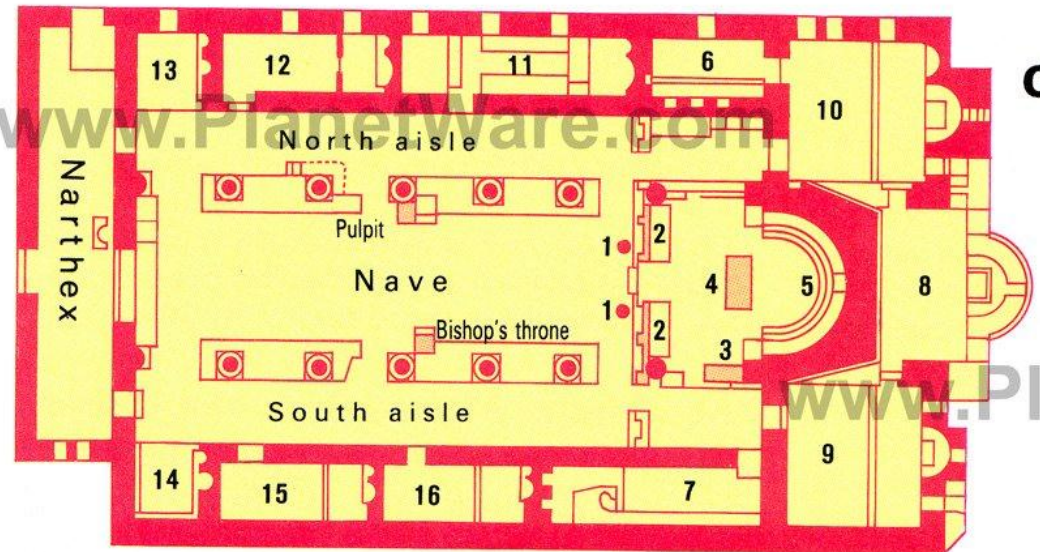
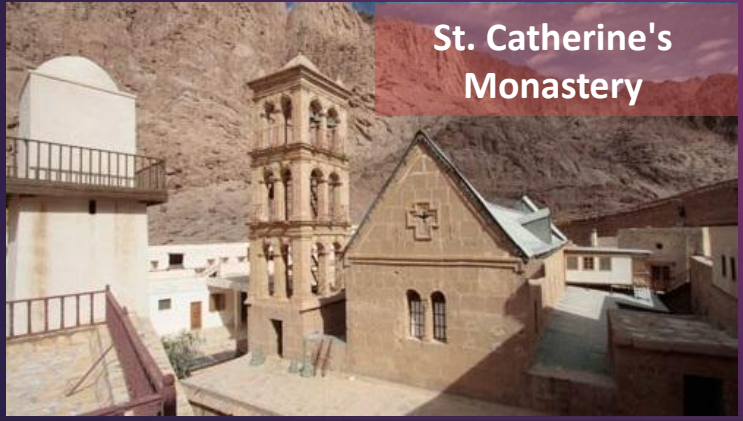


St. Catherine's Monastery



The difference between a monastery / church / cathedral ?

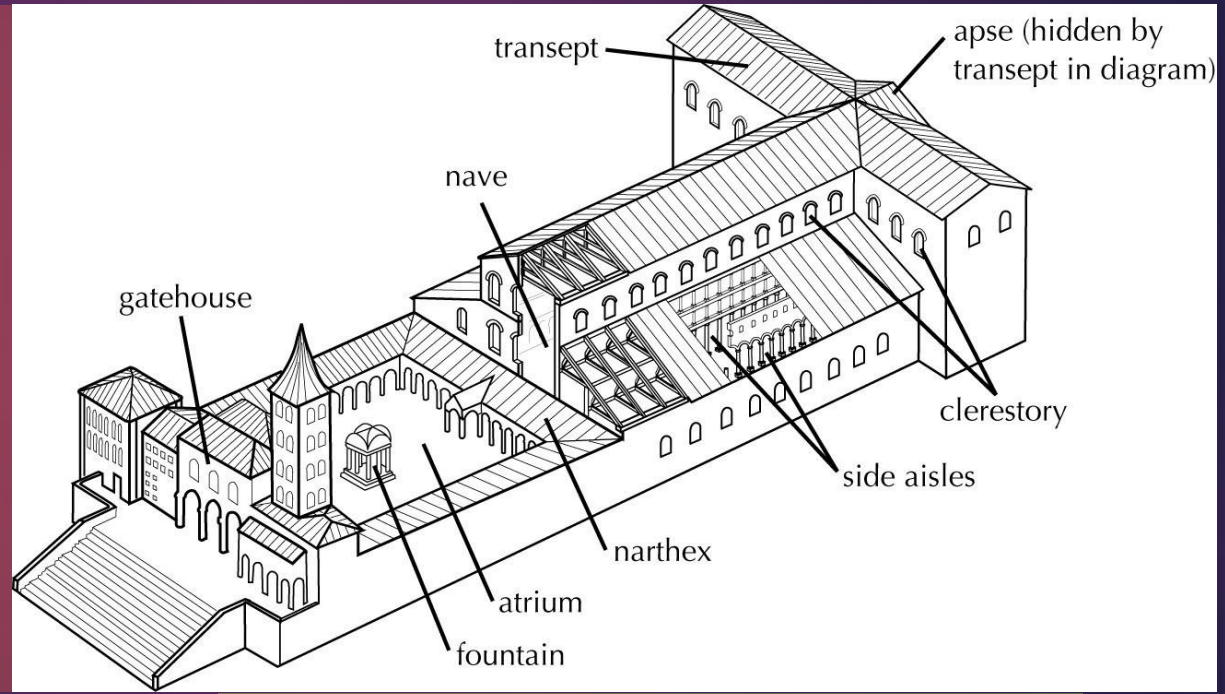
The Church: It is the place of prayer for Christians and the place where the altar is located. It is special for performing prayers, celebrations, gatherings, lessons and religious sermons.
